

Gender Ratio in UR's Committees, Central Level









Gender Ratio in UR's Committees, Decentralized Level





Share of women 2013 to 2023





Share of Women Professors in W2/C3 and W3/C4 Professorships in FTEs























total number in 2020: 331 (f=62, m=269); total number in 2023: 362 (f=86, m=276)




Junior and Tenure-Track Professorships





Faculty of Law, Share of Women 2018 – 2023



Faculty of Business, Economics and Management Information Systems, Share of Women 2018 – 2023



Faculty of Medicine (with UKR), Share of Women 2018 – 2023



Faculty of Philosophy, Art History, History and Humanities, Share of Women 2018 – 2023

















- **Figures UR professorships** | Sources for reporting date 1.12.2023: Department I/7, list of full-time equivalents (professorships are counted here without substitute professorships, without adjunct professorships, but including those on leave of absence and employees financed by third party grants; including Medicine UR and departments that belong to the Faculty of Medicine) – The data report uses the figures for full-time equivalents; the head count figures are to be distinguished from these. If head counts are used, then source: Department I/7, list of professorships, head counts.
