

International mobility grants for women scientists

Call for applications and funding guidelines

The University of Regensburg (UR) is launching a cross-faculty program to fund long term, in-depth research trips abroad to further qualification and encourage international networking to provide targeted support for women academics.

Target group | Advanced female doctoral candidates, postdoctoral researchers, habilitation candidates, private lecturers at the UR with temporary employment contracts as well as W1 professors.

Prerequisites

- Duration of the planned stay abroad: at least six weeks; maximum three months.
- Very good academic performance and prognosis.
- Funding is possible for foreign female academics if the last academic degree was obtained in Germany.
- Only one-time funding is possible.
- Information about other applications for funding for the same stay must be provided when submitting the application

Scope of funding

- Travel costs in accordance with the Bavarian Travel Expenses Act up to a maximum of 1.400€.
- Accommodation costs in accordance with the rates of the Bavarian Travel Expenses Act up to a maximum of 1.200€ per month for a maximum of three months.
- Allowance for childcare costs up to a maximum of 500€
- Funding of the teaching assignments (Lehraufträge) during the mobility grant period. A justification as to why the courses cannot be taught in block format must be enclosed with the application. Lump sums of 700€ per 2 SWS in the summer semester and 750€ in the winter semester; maximum of 1.500€ per application.

Application documents

- Cover Letter
- CV
- Abstract of the research project (max. two pages)
- Cost planning
- Brief endorsement of the research trip by the supervisor of the dissertation or habilitation
- Invitation or confirmation from the institution where the research will take place

Proof of use | Funding recipients must submit a brief report on the use of the funds and an assessment of the impact on their own career development to the Equal Opportunities Coordination Office (chancengleichheit@ur.de) no later than 8 weeks after the end of the stay abroad.
