on the exchange program of the Faculty of Medicine (Practical Year – Human Medicine)

The University of Regensburg maintains partnerships with other universities in the field of Medicine. There is the possibility for students to perform a part of their **Practical Year (PY)** at a partner university abroad.

The duration of a PY-stay as a part of the exchange program can last **up to 4 months**. Every partner university offers **up to 2 study abroad spots** each application date.

A multiple application for 2 exchange programs is possible. (Please note in the application form!)

A selection process takes place (possibly also a selection interview).

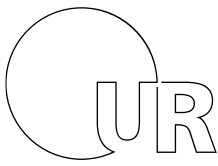

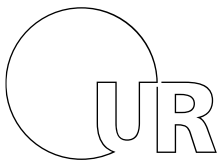
